'I wish to amuse, intrigue and tell. The benevolence of the clay to allow itself to be shaped, incised, built and joined bit-by-bit gives me a three-dimensional language with rich opportunities. The material demands a concentrated collaboration and it invites to ever-new challenges and a deeper acquaintance. I let myself be challenged, I wish to have control, but I willingly come along on a journey into unknown territory. My works lie within a relatively strict and controlled style, yet they are apt to be playful and subtle and they are often based on linguistic antics or interpersonal relations. I am comfortable in the intersection between art and craft, between sculpture and function, and I hope my works can open up to fabling and reflection in the individual.'





The path from soft clay to hard and durable ceramics takes time, care and a respect for the material - a material that in the end will be fired to over 1200 °C to obtain its strength and final shape. After rolling, building and modelling each unique object, the clay is dried and fired a first time, and it then passes from clay to ceramics.


The next step is coloring with glazes and oxides, and then another firing to a higher temperature. Maybe I also want a lustre detail on the balloons, houses, cups or some of my other sculptural works, which then demands yet another firing before the item can be approved.

Other sculptures has parts or details in other materials. Most of my 'soaring' stoneware balloons are not finished until the wire with a small readymade figure is tied to it. Only then they have become a "balloon fairytale" - a story about a journey.

I wish you a pleasant trip into my ceramics world!


